



#### 1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

#### **Project Description:**


Work under this contract consists of safety/streetscape improvements along New Jersey Avenue, NW from N Street NW to H Street NW and the reconstruction New York Avenue, NW from First Street NW to 4th Street NW. The work includes but is not limited to the following items: Installation of new curb, gutter, and sidewalk; Installation of full depth pavement, Pavement resurfacing; Installation of utilities; Installation of flexible pavement; Installation of street light poles; Installation of traffic signals; Installation of signing and pavement markings; Installation of electrical duct bank; Relocation of over-height detection system; Installation of wireless vehicle detection system; Installation of landscape improvements; Installation of erosion and sediment control; Implementation of transportation management plan; Mobilization and demobilization, provision and maintenance of work and storage areas, Engineer's field facilities and performance of employee training; Removal and disposal of any material as a result of the activities listed above, unless stated otherwise in the contract drawings.

This project is 83.15% Federally Funded and 16.85% District-Funded. DDOT selected Capitol Paving of DC, Inc. (CPDC) as the contractor and awarded the \$12,055,691.00 contract on January 9, 2019. DDOT issued notice to proceed with contract work to CPDC with work to begin on 05/13/2019 and a substantial completion date of 11/23/2020.


