## Lane Closures and Detour on New Jersey Avenue NW August 7-8

(Washington, DC) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will implement lane closures and a temporary detour on northbound New Jersey Avenue NW from 9:30 a.m. on or about Friday August 7, 2020 to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday August 8, 2020, weather permitting. A marked detour plan will be in place during the closure.

This work is necessary for construction activities associated with the Safety Improvements on New Jersey Avenue NW project which includes the reconstruction of the New York Avenue NW and New Jersey Avenue intersection. The northbound traffic on New Jersey Avenue NW will be restricted to through traffic only across the New York Avenue NW intersection. The right turn lane onto eastbound New York Avenue NW will be closed. The northbound traffic needing to access New York Avenue NW will be detoured at K Street NW and L Street NW, as exhibited in the graphic below.

Detour signs will also be prevalent along the closure route to guide motorists safely around the closure. Motorists should expect delays due to the lane closures, and are advised to stay alert and be observant of signage and road work crews while traveling in this area.
